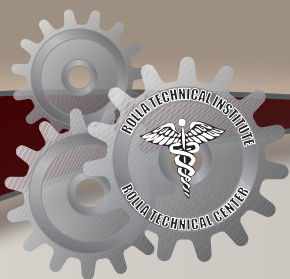
Students who participate in the Health Science Academy Program and meet certain requirements may qualify for priority selection into RTI/C's allied health or Practical Nursing programs.
