## <u>SELECTION</u>

Applications will be reviewed and selected by the Admission/Selection Committee without consideration of age, marital status, sex, national origin, race, color, creed, disability and/or religion to the extent required by the law. This policy will be adhered to throughout the program and district. (Refer to Rolla School District Policy AC and Procedure AC-AP)

Applicants whose records indicate the greatest potential for achievement in nursing will be selected. The selection process is discussed with applicants at the time of the informational session.

Each year, RTC administration, allied health and nursing program directors, and faculty review the admission criteria and make the necessary changes to maintain the high quality of programs at RTC.

## <u>Please Note</u>: In accordance with Missouri State Board of Nursing Minimum Standards for Practical Nursing Education, a student may not be admitted to the program after five (5) class days have elapsed.

## FOLLOWING SELECTION

- 1. A physical examination is required (to include up to date immunizations)
- 2. An initial drug screening panel (i.e., 6, 10 or more) as required per school and facility policy
- 3. Attendance at summer orientation session
